

Sinai Covenant: The Book of the Covenant

Exodus 19 - The initiating proposal, Pre-acceptance, the nation sanctified.

Exodus 20 – The 10 Commandments, the people request not to hear YHWH's voice.

Exodus 21-23 – The Judgements, Civil codes, Appointed times, Shmita year (Seventh Year Sabbath).

Exodus 24 - Post Acceptance, the Final Acceptance, Blood Ratification, and the Covenant Confirming Meal.

Blood Covenant – Marriage Covenant

Sinai Covenant: The Book of the Covenant

Exodus 24:3-11

[3] And Moses came and told the people all the words of YHWH, and all the judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which YHWH hath said will we do. [4] And Moses wrote all the words of YHWH, and rose up early in the morning, and builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel. [5] And he sent young men of the children of Israel, which offered burnt offerings, and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen unto YHWH. [6] And Moses took half of the blood, and put it in basons; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. [7] And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that YHWH hath said will we do, and be obedient. [8] And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which YHWH hath made with you concerning all these words. [9] Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel: [10] And they saw the Elohim of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness. [11] And upon the nobles of the children of Israel he laid not his hand: also they saw Elohim, and did eat and drink.

Galatians 3:15 Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's covenant, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto.

Hebrews 7:11-16

[11] If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchizedek, and not be called after the order of Aaron? [12] For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law. [13] For he of whom these things are spoken pertaineth to another tribe, of which no man gave attendance at the altar. [14] For it is evident that our Master sprang out of Judah; of which tribe Moses spake nothing concerning priesthood. [15] And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchizedek there ariseth another priest, [16] Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life.

Hebrews 9:1-10

[1] also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. [2] For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary. [3] And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; [4] Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; [5] And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly. [6] Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of Elohim. [7] But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people: [8] The Holy Spirit this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing: [9] Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience; [10] Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them **until the time of reformation**.

YHWH's 2 Covenants With Ancient Israel

MT. SINAI (HOREB) and LAND of MOAB **Deuteronomy 29:1**

[1] These are the words of the covenant, which YHWH commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab,

... beside the covenant which he made with them in Horeb (Mt. Sinai).

1st (Sinai) Exodus 19:5-Exodus 24:11

2nd (Moab) Exodus 24:12 – Deuteronomy



I Kings 8:9 There was nothing in the ark except the two stone tablets Moses had placed in it at Horeb, the tablets of the covenant which YHWH had made with the Israelites when they came out of the land of Egypt..." (1 Kings 8:1-9).

What animals were Sacrificed and what was sprinkled? Covenant at SINAI (HOREB) and MOAB

Sinai Covenant – Exodus 24:5-8

[5] And he sent young men of the children of Israel, which offered burnt offerings, and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen unto YHWH.[6] And Moses took half of the blood, and put it in basons; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. [7] And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that YHWH hath said will we do, and be obedient. [8] And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which YHWH hath made with you concerning all these words.

Moab Covenant – **Hebrews 9:19-21**

[19] For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, [20] Saying, This is the blood of the testament which Elohim hath enjoined unto you. [21] Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry.

What animals were Sacrificed and what was sprinkled? Covenant at SINAI (HOREB) and MOAB

Moab Covenant – Hebrews 9:19-21

Strong's Number: 1781, from (<u>1722</u>) and the base of (<u>5056</u>)

Verb

Definition: to order, command to be done, enjoin

We know that the Levites/the Sons of Aaron became the Priests of Israel after the Golden Calf incident.

Who were the priests prior to the Aaronic prieshood?

Exodus 19:5-6

- [5] Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: [6] And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of **priests**, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.
- [22] And let the **priests** also, which come near to YHWH, sanctify themselves, lest YHWH break forth upon them.
- [24] And YHWH said unto him, Away, get thee down, and thou shalt come up, thou, and Aaron with thee: but let not the **priests** and the people break through to come up unto YHWH, lest he break forth upon them.

Who were the priests prior to the Aaronic prieshood?

Numbers 3:12-13

[12] And I, behold, I have taken the Levites from among the children of Israel instead of all the firstborn that openeth the matrix among the children of Israel: therefore the Levites shall be mine; [13] Because all the firstborn are mine; for on the day that I smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt I hallowed unto me all the firstborn in Israel, both man and beast: mine shall they be: I am YHWH.


Melchizedek Priests

II Peter 2:4-5

- [4] For if Elohim spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;
- [5] And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth *person*, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

Melchizedek Priests

Exodus 3: (the Elohim of the Malki-Tzedek calls Moshe into the priesthood)

Exodus 32:31 (Moshe, the last kadosh Malki Tzedek intercedes)

We know that the Levites/the Sons of Aaron became the Priests of Israel after the Golden Calf incident and tithes and offerings were overseen by them.



Who did the Israelites give their tithes and who did the offerings before that?



Tithes Before the Levitical Priesthood

Genesis 14:18-20

[18] And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high Elohim. [19] And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high Elohim, possessor of heaven and earth: [20] And blessed be the most high Elohim, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him **tithes** of all.

Genesis 28:20-22

[20] And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If Elohim will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on, [21] So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall YHWH be my Elohim: [22] And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be Elohim's house: and of all that thou shalt give me I will surely give the **tenth** unto thee.

Exodus 20:24-25 (Book of the Covenant)

[24] An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee. [25] And if thou wilt make me an altar of stone, thou shalt not build it of hewn stone: for if thou lift up thy tool upon it, thou hast polluted it.

Exodus 24:4-5 (Book of the Covenant)

[4] And Moses wrote all the words of YHWH, and rose up early in the morning, and builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel. No Levitical Priesthood until after the Golden Calf So this must be talking about the "Book of the Law", not the "Book of the Covenant"

Galatians 3:17-18

- [17] And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of Elohim in Messiah, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect.
- [18] For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: but Elohim gave it to Abraham by promise.

Book of the Covenant or Book of the Law Troublesome Scriptures Clarified?

Galatians 3:17-18

[17] And this I say, that the covenant (1), that was confirmed before of Elohim in Messiah, the law (2), which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise (3) of none effect. [18] For if the inheritance (1) be of the law (2), it is no more of promise (3): but Elohim gave it to Abraham by promise (3).

The Book of the Covenant (1) is the inheritance (1) or Answer to the Promise Covenant (3) made in Genesis 15. The Inheritance Covenant/Book of the Covenant(1) along with the promise (3) made at Genesis 15 are NOT part of the Book of the Law (2).

Galatians 3:19 Wherefore then serveth the (book of the) law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

Is Paul saying, "the law was added to the law because of transgression to the law?"

Galatians 3:19 Wherefore then serveth the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

The word "added" is translated from the Greek:

Prostithemi

Where we get our English words prosthetic or prostheses.

Galatians 3:12 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.

Exodus 19.8 & Exodus 24:3 the children of Israel answered; "all that 'has spoken we will do." and they accepted the Book of the Covenant law IN FAITH, so Galatians 3:12 CANNOT be referring to Book of the Covenant but a SEPARATE law that was NOT OF FAITH.

Hebrews 10:1-8 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. [2] For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. [3] But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. [4] For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. [5] Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: [6] In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. [7] Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O Elohim. [8] Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law;

Book of the Covenant or Book of the Law Troublesome Scriptures Clarified?

<u>Deuteronomy 28:15</u> But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of YHWH thy Elohim, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

<u>Deuteronomy 29:21</u> And YHWH shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law:

Is this speaking of the Book of the Covenant or the Book of the Law?

The Book of the Covenant only had <u>maybe</u> one curse. <u>Exodus 20:4-6</u> [4] Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: [5] Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I YHWH thy Elohim am a jealous Elohim, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; [6] And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

2 Corinthians 3:12-18 [12] Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech: [13] And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished: [14] But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Messiah. [15] But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. [16] Nevertheless when it shall turn to Messiah, the vail shall be taken away. [17] Now YHWH is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of YHWH is, there is liberty. [18] But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of YHWH, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of YHWH. 37

- The Jewish "vail" of confusion in reading the Old Testament is that Most Jews understand that the 'Law of Moses' preserved the lives of Israel for violation of the covenant.
- Most Jews do NOT fully recognize that the 'Law of Moses' which is the "Book of the Law" (Moab Covenant) was to remain IN ADMINISTRATION only UNTIL the death penalty position could be paid (the Genesis 49:10 'Until Shiloh comes' clause) allowing all Israel access back to the covenants of promise; of which the Book of the law of Moses is NOT. And re-establishing the Melchizedek Priest.

- The Christian "vail" of confusion in reading the Old Testament is that most Christians don't know that much of the 'Law of Moses' was rendered useless when Yahshua established a new blood covenant and re-established the Melchizedek priesthood.
- Most Christians do NOT fully understand that the 'Law of Moses' was a distinct law enacted and not the whole of the Old Testament 'covenant law'.
- Most Christians do NOT realize that the blood covenant that was made new by Yahshua has Torah/teachings covenant law and instructions attached to it.
- Most Christians set aside TOO MUCH of the Instructions of covenant because of a misunderstanding of the law and grace.

Troublesome Scriptures Clarified?

The veil is there for BOTH Christian and Jew UNTIL, their hearts are turned to יהוה covenants of promise and follow the 'teaching and instructions/torah of the covenants of promise.

Ephesians 2:12-15

That at that time ye were without Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: But now in Messiah Yahshua ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Messiah. For Yahshua is our peace, He who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is the (Book of the) Law of commandments contained in ordinances (not covenant), so as to create in Himself ONE NEW MAN from the two thus making SHALOM.

1 Chronicles 16:7-17

[7] Then on that day David delivered first this psalm to thank YHWH into the hand of Asaph and his brethren. [8] Give thanks unto YHWH, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. [9] Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. [10] Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek YHWH. [11] Seek YHWH and his strength, seek his face continually. [12] Remember his marvellous works that he hath done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth; [13] O ye seed of Israel his servant, ye children of Jacob, his chosen ones. [14] He is YHWH our Elohim; his judgments are in all the earth. [15] Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word which he commanded to a thousand generations; [16] Even of the covenant which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac; [17] And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant,

Book of the Covenant or Book of the Law

Passover: Exodus 12: Each head of household sacrificed the Passover Lamb.

Under the book of the law — you took your lamb to the tabernacle/temple and the Priest killed the lamb.

Book of the Covenant or Book of the Law

Circumcision: Circumcision was a sign of the covenant with Abraham and his decedents.

After the Golden Calf incident those children were no longer circumcised until under Joshua, they were circumcised going into the Promised Land.

Ezekiel 11:19 And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and

I will give them an heart of flesh:

Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

II Corinthians 3:3 For you know that you are a letter of The Messiah that is ministered by us, written not in ink, but by The Spirit of THE LIVING Elohim, not in tablets of stone, but in tablets of hearts of flesh.

Covenant of the Pieces – Abram didn't pass through – Only YHWH, signifying that if either party to the covenant broke it, YHWH would pay penalty.

What does this mean for us?


1. That we are under the Melchizedek Priesthood of Yahshua, not the Levitical Priesthood.


2. Clarifies scripture, especially the N.T.
